ENTRANCE TEST AND HALL TICKET

1. Group wise Entrance Test for Non C.U. and C.U. applicants will be held.
2. One common Entrance Test will be held for one Group of applications

e.g. A : Group-1) Application Form of Physics Hons. Graduates with order of Preference for admission to M.Sc. in PH1, ES1,ES2, PH2, PH3, and B.Tech. in ECE (formerly Radio physics & Electronics), IT, CSE, EE, IE, OO, and or its any part.

e.g. B : Group-2) Application Form of Electronics Hons. Graduates with order of Preference for admission to M.Sc. in ES1, ES2 and B.Tech. in ECE (formerly Radiophysics & Electronics), IT, OO, or its any part.

e.g. C :Group-15) Application Form of Geography Hons. Graduates with order of Preference for admission to M.Sc. in **GG1, GG2, GG3, GG4, GG5, GG6, GG7, GG8, GG9** or its any part.

3. *A common Entrance Test will be held for the Groups 8, 9,16,17,18,22,24 as common Group no. 30*
4. Each Entrance Test will be of one hour duration except few specially mentioned. Full marks for each Entrance Test will be of 100 marks except few specially mentioned. Number of questions in each test will be of 50 and each question should have four options of answers of which one will be correct answer. For each correct answer scoring will be +2 marks and negative marking of -0.5 marks for each wrong answer and for no try there will be 0 marks.
5. DOWNLOAD e-Hall Ticket for Entrance Test
 - The e-Hall Ticket will not be sent to you via post or fax.
 - Please download e-Hall Ticket and take printout from the website on prescribed time to be notified in the Admission Schedule.
 - Paste two recent self attested passport size (3.5cm x 3.5cm) photograph on the prescribed space of e-hall ticket.
 - Take a minute to check that all the information on the e-Hall Ticket is clearly legible, especially your photograph and signature.
 - No applicant will be permitted to appear for the test without a valid e-Hall Ticket.
 - You must not deface the e-Hall Ticket, or attempt to change any information on it.
 - The e-Hall Ticket is also not transferable to anyone else. Impersonation is a legally punishable offence.
 - The e-Hall Ticket is an important document; it must be preserved and produced at the time of Interview / admission.

6. ON THE DAY OF THE ENTRANCE TEST WHEN YOU REPORT TO THE TEST CENTRE, YOU NEED BRING WITH YOU:

- a) e-Hall Ticket with pasting of self attested recent passport size photograph in the space specified.
- b) Any one of the following for photo Identification :
 - Passport
 - Driving Licence
 - EC Voter ID Card
 - Adhar Card
 - IT Pan Card
 - School / College photo bearing ID Card

7. There will be two main merit lists in each group of applications (a) one for Part – “A” Mode of selection mentioned above and (b) other for Part – “B”. only on the marks obtained in Entrance Test.

8. All Non-C.U. applicants and C.U. previous year candidate have to appear in the Entrance Test and will be placed in the Merit list of Part “B” only.

9. Any C.U. applicant may or may not appear in Entrance Test where Entrance Test is not mandatory.

10. If any C.U. applicant does not appear in the Entrance Test where Entrance Test is not mandatory then the applicant will be placed in the Merit List of Part – “A” only.

11. If any C.U. applicant does appear in the Entrance Test then they will be placed in the Merit List of both Part – “A” & Part - “B”

12. In case where Entrance Test is Mandatory for both and C.U. and Non-C.U. candidate (Group – 3, 8, 13, 21, 23), the candidate will not be in the Merit List if he or she fails to appear in the Entrance Test.

13. Faculty of Agriculture:

All the B.Sc. (Ag) applicants have to appear in written Entrance Test of 100 marks both MCQ and short type answer question.

Qualifying marks in Entrance Test will be 30% i.e. 30 marks.

Merit list will be prepared accordingly.

There will be no negative marking

Counseling of the qualifying candidates will be followed
