## **SECTION - 15**

## FOR NON - C.U. CANDIDATES

- 1) 80% of total seat in each course be earmarked for C.U. students only. This 80% of total seat be termed as **Part- "A"** seat in each course. All the current year and immediate preceding year C.U Honours Graduate students will be considered in **Part "A"**.
- 2) Rest 20% of total seat in each course be earmarked for Non-C.U. candidates. This 20% of total seat be termed **as Part "B"** seat in each course.

## Part - B:

Non-C.U. candidate means the candidate who passed the required Bachelor Examination as eligibility degree for admission in relevant P.G. courses from the University other than Calcutta University.

Non-C.U. Honours graduates or its equivalent of the current year and of the immediate preceding year for all courses.

- 1. Honours graduate or, its equivalent of Other Indian Universities of (10+2+3) pattern. Candidates passing Honours in Science with 1<sup>st</sup> class in undergraduate level from Indira Gandhi National Open University, Netaji Subhas Open University and the Distance Education Programme of Other Universities in West Bengal of current year and immediate preceding year.
- 2. Non-C.U. Hons. Graduates in Statistics and Mathematics are not eligible to apply for B.Tech. Computer Science & Engineering.
- 3. Course wise eligibility criteria of both C.U. and Non-C.U. candidate are same.
- 4. For Hostel Facility please see "Post Admission" Section.
- 5. **All Non-C.U. students admitted in the P.G. Courses** must have to submit application for **Registration at Calcutta University** in prescribed format along with **Original Migration Certificate** from previous University **within a month of admission**.

All PART - B (NON -CU) Candidate have to go through Entrance Test.

PART-B (NON-CU) Candidates have to pay Entrance Test Fee for each Group of Application.
